### **Walk-in registration**

Participants are able to walk-in to the location during the allocated vaccine clinic times.

### **Why is vaccination being recommended?**

Vaccines are safe and are one of the infection prevention and control measures you can take to protect yourself from getting very sick and being hospitalized with COVID-19. It is also important for the protection of our youngest children (0-4) years, who are not yet eligible for vaccine protection.

### **Who can attend this vaccination clinic?**

This clinic is open to students from St. Ann (Hamilton) Catholic Elementary School, Holy Name of Jesus Catholic Elementary School, St. Patrick Catholic Elementary School, and St. Lawrence Catholic Elementary School. First and second doses are also available to family members.

### **Consent**

Students aged 5 to 11 require parental or guardian consent in order to participate in the vaccine clinic. If parents/guardians wish to have their children vaccinated, they are asked to sign and return the [consent form](#) to the school. A completed consent form is only required if the parent/guardian will not be attending the clinic with the child. Health cards are preferred, but other pieces of identification are accepted, such as a birth certificate, passport, library card, social insurance number card or other government-issued identification. Two pieces of ID are required if you do not have a health card.

### **Preparing Your Child for Vaccination**

While COVID-19 vaccinations are safe, we understand you or your child may have questions about the vaccine. Please speak to your child about the many benefits of being vaccinated against COVID-19.
